The professorship honors Dr. Louise McBee, who held leadership positions at the University of Georgia before serving for over a decade as a champion for higher education in the Georgia legislature.

We seek a scholar of national and international prominence who will advance the multi-disciplinary character of the McBee Institute, add substantially to the depth and breadth of our faculty, and develop improved understanding of higher education.

Candidates should hold a doctorate in sociology, political science, higher education, public policy, economics, management or a related field, and they should bring a distinguished record in instruction, scholarly research, and extramural funding focused on the study of higher education.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach graduate-level courses, advise and mentor doctoral students, pursue an active program of research, and apply research-based knowledge to improving practice and policy in higher education.

Review of applications will begin October 19, 2022 and continue until the position is filled; candidates who apply by November 4 will receive full consideration.
